Bench Options



People of all ages visit Box Elder's trails and playgrounds every day, and the city parks are host to numerous events and other community gatherings. Your bench will be recognized and appreciated by visitors for decades to come. The Bench option is a way for community members to sponsor their group, business, organization or to memorialize and honor the memory of a friend or loved one within the City of Box Elder's Park system. There are no eligibility requirements for participation.

### **Memorial Bench Option**

The Memorial option allows friends and family to honor the memory of a loved one with a park bench in one of Box Elder's beautiful parks or along the trail system. Dedicating a park bench provides a lasting remembrance in honor of a loved one and enhances the meaning of a bench for park visitors. The gift is also a valuable contribution to the community's park system.

### **Sponsorship Bench Option**

The Sponsorship option allows groups, businesses, and organizations to sponsor a bench in one of Box Elder's beautiful parks or along the trail system. While providing recognition for your group, business, or organization it also enhances the leisure space for park visitors and is a valuable contribution to the community's park system.

### **Can I choose the location?**

Yes! The City has designated areas where benches can be installed within our parks and trails system. You will work with Parks staff to determine placement.

### **How does the program work?**

The City of Box Elder will install a concrete bench pad and secure the six-foot bench to the pad. The City will maintain the bench in a manner to other similar park equipment. The engraved plaque is attached to the bench's backrest. The 4"x6" bronze plaque is limited to 6 lines with up to 30 characters per line.

### **What is the cost?**

Bench Memorial (cost \$1,300 per bench)
